

**TAITO PIRKANMAA OY
PIRKKA- PAPER YARNS**

Pirkka yarns of Taito Pirkanmaa Oy have been on market almost 50 years. Development of classical, quality Pirkka yarns continued decades. Color card follow the sign of the time.

Pirkka yarns are Finnish yarns, spun, dyed and belted in Finland. In dyeing are used EU approved reactive colors. Working conditions is by regulation of environmental instructions.

Paper yarns are made of softwood pulp. The paper material has PEFC certifications.

Pirkka paper yarns are ecological yarns. They are durable, recyclable and the dyeing process does not burden nature. The processing of the yarns takes place in a small area, which minimizes transport.

LIGHT PERIOD on a scale of 1-7

Dark and yellow 5-6 (excellent)

Light tones 3-5 (good)

The white yarn turns yellow slightly under the influence of sunlight over time.

WASHING

Hand wash in 40 degree water. The surface can be brushed lightly with a soft brush. Does not withstand machine washing, spinning, tumble drying or chemical washing. The product must be shaped damp and dried on an airy surface as a level. Can be ironed with iron up to 110 degrees.

Paper yarn can also be fire retardant.
